Reports and individual goals

Our St Martin's Teachers have been very busy assessing children's progress and writing reports. Our usual end of semester parent-teacher interviews will be three-way conversations this term with students involved in the discussion with their parents and teachers. The goal setting interviews, to be held at the end of this term, have been extended to 15 minute interviews (with 5 minute change over) following feedback from parents about term one goal setting interviews.

The Teachers have all spent considerable time and put much thought into preparing student reports, reviewing goals achieved and setting new individualised goals with students. We are indeed very blessed to have such a committed and professional Teaching staff, who always have the children's learning and wellbeing as their main focus.

Scholastic Book Club




